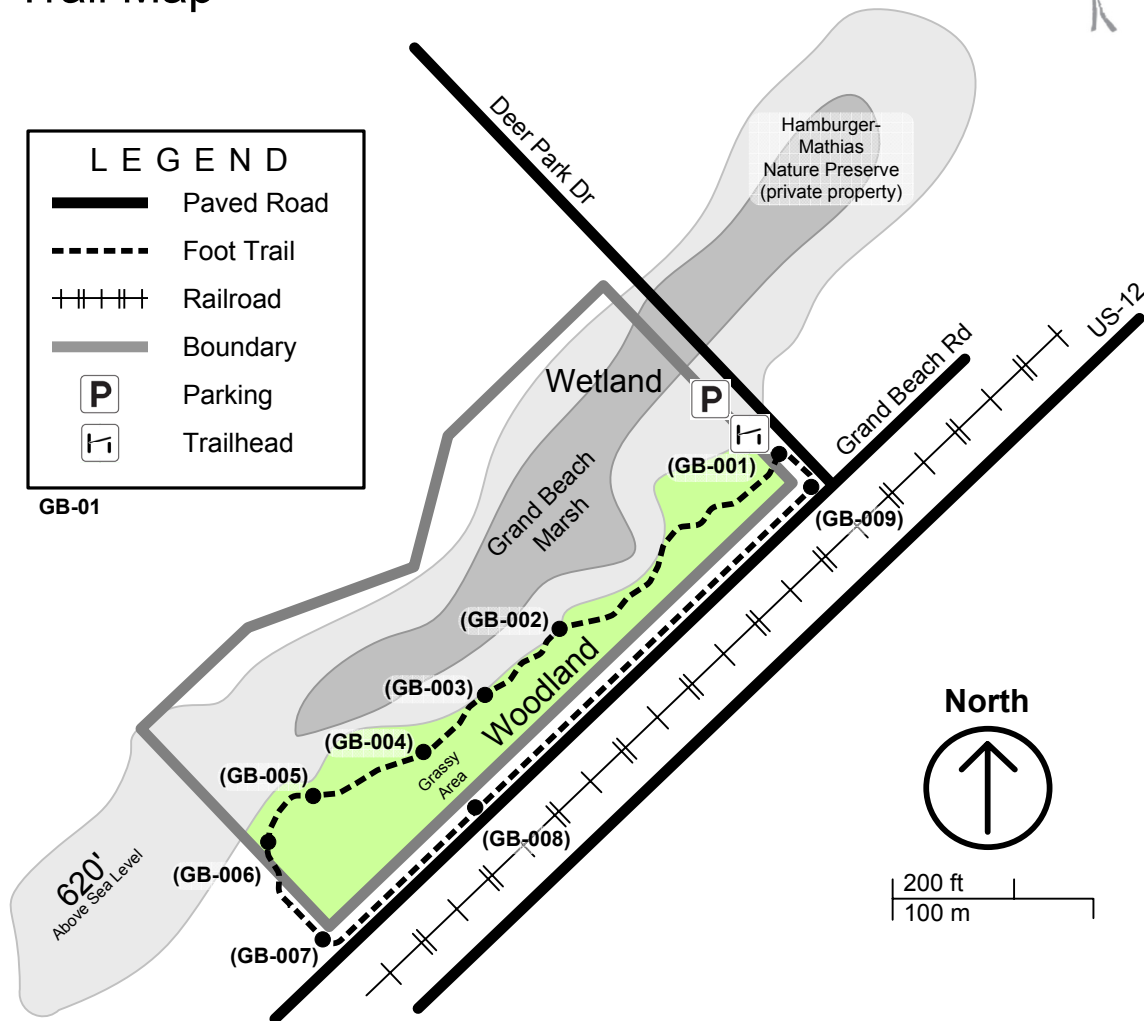


# Grand Beach Marsh Preserve Trail Map



**Note:** Reference Trail Guide for Waypoint Chart.

**Preserve Information:** The Preserve is an 11-acre gem that provides an outstanding example of a globally rare coastal plain marsh and is home to several rare or declining plant and animal species. This trail has a difficulty rating of easy.

**Entrance:** GPS 41.77677, -86.77896

**Distance Round-Trip:** 0.44 miles

**Directions:** From US-12, take the Grand Beach access road. After crossing the tracks, turn northeast (right) onto Grand Beach Road for 0.7 miles to Deer Park Drive. Then turn northwest (left) and watch for the preserve sign on the left. Park alongside the road.

**Hours Open:** Open year-round, from sunrise to sunset.
